

Filling out your application

- All NEW applications must include: a copy of a valid WI driver's license or state issued ID, and a copy of a certificate of completion for the Responsible Beverage Service Course within the last two years, or an operator's license issued within the last two years from another Wisconsin municipality must be provided. (You can find approved courses at www.revenue.wi.gov/training/alcSellerServer.html).
- Licenses are renewed every two years (in odd years) and are good from July 1st to June 30th. The cost for renewing a license is \$45. If applying for a new license during the first year of the current license period the cost is \$45. If applying for a new license during the second year of the current license period the cost is \$25.

Review of your application

• The City of Kiel Police Department will review your application and return to the City Clerk upon approval.

ALL LICENSE APPLICATIONS INCLUDE A BACKGROUND CHECK. IF YOUR APPLICATION SHOULD BE DENIED YOU CANNOT RE-APPLY UNTIL 6 MONTHS AFTER THE DENIAL DATE

PARAMETERS FOR DENIAL OF AN OPERATOR'S LICENSE (BARTENDER LICENSE)

If you have <u>three or more convictions of</u> the offenses listed or a combination of three or more convictions of the offenses, your application <u>will be</u> recommended for denial. A FELONY conviction substantially related to alcohol activity WILL be an automatic denial.

1. Giving false, incomplete information, misinformation, or failure to disclose on the Application

2.An arrest or conviction of underage selling during the past 5 (five) years.

3.An arrest or conviction of underage person on premise during the past 5 (five) years.

4. Conviction of any substance abuse during the past 5 (five) years.

5. Conviction of driving under the influence of any alcohol or controlled substance during the past 5 (five) years.

6. Conviction of selling to an intoxicated person during the past 5 (five) years.

7. Conviction of selling after hours in the past 5 (five) years.

8. Conviction of selling without a license in the past 5 (five) years.

9. Conviction of any part of Chapter 125 State Statutes, not listed above, relating to alcohol beverages during the past 5 (five) years. 10. An arrest or conviction of charges related to the activities performed while bartending within the past 5 (five) years.

The City Police Chief and City Clerk will review applications. Applications that are denied will be submitted to City Council for either approval or denial at regularly scheduled Council meetings. If the license is denied at the City Council Meeting, the Clerk shall provide the applicant a letter with reasons for denial of their license. Any applicant denied a license may appeal the decision by writing a letter to the City Clerk within 14 days of receipt of the denial letter. The letter should state in detail the grounds for reversal of the denial and shall be signed by the applicant. The Clerk shall submit the letter and application to the City Council for further review.
